Ambulation:



Gait pacer (or gait trainer). "Gait" means walking



Rifton Tram (for transfer and mobility)

Trikes and Bikes:



Rifton adaptive trike



Freedom Concepts adaptive trike



Adult regular trike



Adult bike with training wheels

Walkers:



Kaye style walker



Rollator rolling walker



Folding front wheel walker

Standers:



Rifton supine stander
(person's back against wood)



Prone stander
(person's front against stander)



EasyStand stander (sit-to-stand)

Types of patient lifts:

1. Total Patient floor lifts
